the ages of 16 and 23. It covers many of the fundamentals of the Christian faith as well as addressing some of the more practical issues relevant to your life.

As in nature, Chrysalis marks a stage in the development of any young Christian as he or she matures into fully committed discipleship.

Recognising the differing lifestyles and needs between school-going teenagers and young adults the Chrysalis weekend caters for two groups:

A Chrysalis 'Flight' is for school-going teenagers in Grade 11 or 12.

A Chrysalis 'Journey' caters for young adults from 19 to 23.

What happens at Chrysalis?

You will spend three days with other young people in worship, prayer, fellowship, recreation, singing and discussion. You will experience the Love of Christ through the prayers and acts of service of a loving support community. You will hear talks given to you by other young people, as well as adults who are both lay persons and clergy.

The talks focus on the needs of maturing young people and offer practical messages that can be helpful to your personal faith. You will explore how friendship with Jesus can help you live your life of faith with family, friends and your community.

And you will laugh. A lot!!!

What is Chrysalis?

Chrysalis grew out of the "Walk to Emmaus" movement and is a 3-day course aimed specifically at young people between

What happens after Chrysalis?

One of the primary strengths of Chrysalis is what happens after. Your weekend lasts three days but it is something you can build on through the rest of your life. It will help you to:

- expand your spiritual life through prayer and study.
- become more active as disciples of Christ in the world, in the Church and in your home.

After the weekend Chrysalis encourages participation in:

- small "reunion groups" that meet on a regular basis to maintain spiritual accountability.
- community gatherings for fellowship and worship.
- opportunities and training to support and participate in future Chrysalis courses.

Who should go on Chrysalis?

Chrysalis is for any young Christian who would like to know more about Christ and then make a difference in the world because of this experience.

How to apply to participate in Chrysalis/Journey?

2. A Spiritual sponsor. This is someone who has already attended a Chrysalis course or a Walk to Emmaus and will undertake to explain the weekend as well as pray and assist in practical requirements.

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SPONSOR'S CHECKLIST – CHRYSALIS

Only someone who has been on a Chrysalis Flight or Walk to Emmaus can fulfil this role. Sponsorship does not require paying for participants, but rather ensuring that they derive spiritual benefit from the Flight. It involves:

1. Prayerful selection of applicants in consultation with the sponsor's accountability group and the applicant's minister or pastor.
2. Submitting the application forms and deposit to the registrar for consideration by the PE Emmaus Board.
3. Support for the Flight - before, during and after. This includes the following:
 - Praying for the applicant.
 - Explaining the Flight to the candidate and his/her family before submitting the application form.
 - Discussing the Flight with his/her family/friends for appropriate support, encouragement and care for them over the period of the Flight.
 - Arranging transport to and from the Flight venue.
 - Obtaining agape letters from caterpillar's family and friends.
 - Participating in sponsor's hour, send-off, candlelight and closing.
 - Encouraging the caterpillar to attend follow-up activities after the Flight.

Chrysalis relies on sponsorship to bring other Christians from all walks of life, denominations and races, to share this experience.

The personal nature of sponsorship underlines the personal care and commitment of God to each caterpillar.

As a past caterpillar or pilgrim we all want to share the gift of those 3 days with others. However appropriate sponsorship cannot be overemphasized. The quality of sponsorship ultimately influences the caterpillar; the health of the Emmaus/Chrysalis movement and the local church community. Good sponsorship is the foundation for a strong, effective Emmaus/Chrysalis movement that is fulfilling its true purpose – the development of Christian leaders and the renewal of the church in ministry.

Why do we sponsor?

One should sponsor with the follow aim

- to bring spiritual revitalization to Christians, who in turn will bring new life and vision to the work of the church in the congregation, home, workplace and community and thereby build up the Body of Christ.

Sponsorship is not “to get all my friends to go”, to fill up the weekend, or to fix people’s problems. Things to avoid in sponsorship:

- Do not sponsor a caterpillar because you believe they will have fun!
- Preferably do not sponsor if you are on team for the same weekend, because you cannot fulfil your sponsorship duties properly.
- Do not sponsor just because you had a wonderful time.
- Do not tell people they have to attend Chrysalis. Chrysalis is a ministry, it is not the ministry.

Who should go to Chrysalis?

Chrysalis is for growing Christians between the ages of 16 (Grade 11) and 24 who are open to experience the grace and love of God in new ways through the Christian community. More especially, it is for those who will be committed to make a difference as a result of this experience.

(However please remember that a Flight can only accommodate a maximum number from any one congregation, the reason being that too many leaders away from the same church will place a strain on the congregation.)
